Project Summary:

The intent of the Project was to develop a Strategic Assessment of the Honduran Tourism Sector to assist the Honduran Government and in particular the Ministry of Tourism to consider environmental and social consequences of proposed tourism policies, programs and plans. A framework SEA approach was taken considering the development of tourism scenarios, linkages and sustainability analysis. The study also involved the completion of focused issue papers to provide more in-depth analysis of key issues that fed into the SEA approach. The work was completed under a Trust Fund provided by the Norwegian government.

Services Provided:

- * Development of approach to SEA including scenarios
- * Issue focused assessment and preparation of issues papers concerning key aspects of tourism development and socio-environmental impacts.
- * Training course and seminar on SEAs
- * Project coordination
